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IDPH confirms three cases of COVID-19 variant in Iowa

The Iowa Department of Public Health (IDPH) has confirmed three cases of the COVID-19 variant SARS-CoV-2 B.1.1.7. in Iowa. It is believed that the variant, which was first detected in the United Kingdom, can spread more easily than the original strain of SARS-CoV-2. Current COVID-19 vaccines are effective against the variant strain.

Two of the three B.1.1.7 cases were detected in Johnson County and the third in Bremer County. IDPH and local public health departments have begun notifying anyone with whom these people have been in close contact.

The positive cases were identified by the State Hygienic Lab through routine analysis of genetic sequence data. The lab has been participating in the CDC's SARS-CoV-2 Strain Surveillance Program by sending COVID-19 test samples to be sequenced for the B.1.1.7 variant since early December. Lab staff recently began doing their own internal sequencing to look specifically for the variant. These three cases only represent the variant strains that are confirmed through genomic sequencing and may not accurately reflect the true number of variant cases.
