Awards with Descriptions (Page 1 of 2)

### **Excellence in Leadership Award**

Presented each year to an lowa hospital or health system executive who has demonstrated notable achievement in the management of his or her hospital/health system and for dynamic involvement in the broad area of current health affairs.

- Must be a CEO or chief executive of an Iowa hospital who has contributed to the advancement of the profession of hospital/health system administration through demonstrated effectiveness at the local, state or national level.
- Nominee possesses a record of effectiveness in the management of their hospital/health system and evidence community contact and involvement as leaders in the broad spectrum of health care affairs.
- A history of service and involvement in, but not limited to: IHA committees, councils or Board; involvement in AHA activities and/or involvement in other national, state or local health care organizations.
- An explanation why you believe the nominee is deserving of recognition for his/her work as a hospital/health system CEO in Iowa.

### Young Executive Achievement Award

Established as a memorial to James B. Seaman II, a former IHA vice president who was killed in an aircraft accident, the Young Executive Achievement Award is presented each year to an Iowa hospital or health system young chief executive whose achievements are noteworthy.

- Must currently be a CEO or chief executive of an Iowa hospital who has contributed to the advancement of the profession of hospital/health system administration through demonstrated effectiveness at the local, state or national level.
- Nominee exhibits a record of effectiveness in the management of their hospital/health system and evidence community contact and involvement as leaders in the broad spectrum of health care affairs.
- Must be age 40 or younger and employed a minimum of 1 year as a hospital chief executive.
- An explanation why you believe the nominee is deserving of recognition for his/her work as a hospital/health system CEO in Iowa.

#### Awards and Descriptions (cont'd)

### Excellence in Governance Award

The Excellence in Governance Award was established as a memorial to Ernie Hayes who served as a board member and trustee for 40 years for Henry County Health Center in Mount Pleasant. Mr. Hayes' selfless dedication to service continues to benefit people, hospitals and communities throughout Iowa.

- Must be a member of an Iowa hospital or health system board of directors. Someone who focuses management's attention on the past, present and future health care needs of the communities served, the resources of the organization and the action steps needed to successfully merge this information into an action plan for success.
- A diplomat that works in concert with management and medical staff to interface with external, key publics (community, business groups, medical groups, legislators, etc.) to influence their perceptions and actions taken on behalf of the organization.
- A leader is someone who understands the strategic vision of the organization, understands the ambassadorial role, and combines the two in organizing and utilizing resources to achieve goals. A leader gains the respect and trust of the board, medical staff and employees.
- An explanation why you believe the individual is deserving of recognition for his/her work as a hospital/health system trustee in Iowa. The nominee's involvement in IHA activities, programs and education, including participation in the IHA Hospital Board Certification Program, will be considered.
