Continuing resolution funds government through Dec. 16

The Senate voted Thursday and the House voted Friday on a <u>continuing resolution</u> <u>extending federal funding levels</u> for health care and other programs through Friday, Dec. 16.

The legislation also extends two programs maintaining access to care in rural communities: the Medicare-dependent hospital and the enhanced low-volume adjustment programs. Other extended provisions include:

- Reauthorization of the Food and Drug Administration's user-fee programs.
- Emergency funding for Ukraine.
- Disaster assistance.

A proposal in the Senate dealing with energy-permitting plans was dropped from the measure Tuesday, speeding passage of the legislation.

The Department of House and Human Services 405(d) cybersecurity taskforce released a new digital toolkit for Cybersecurity Awareness Month. The toolkit was designed to help health care organizations promote cyber safety as patient safety.

The toolkit is based on cyber-safe behaviors set out by the <u>National Cyber Alliance</u>.
