lowa Medicaid resuming provider enrollment site visits

lowa Medicaid is <u>unwinding some of the flexibilities</u> for provider enrollment implemented by the federal public health emergency. The flexibilities include suspending site visits for newly enrolled providers and enrollment revalidation requirements.

lowa Medicaid is working through a backlog of site visits for providers who enrolled during the public health emergency, beginning with moderate or high-risk provider types. The department is not required to conduct site visits for providers who have already been screened as a moderate risk provider type by Medicare or another state's Medicaid of Children's Health Insurance Program in the past 12 months.

lowa Medicaid also is requiring providers to revalidate their enrollment in phases by provider type beginning with home- and community-based services waiver providers and behavioral health providers.

Public reporting of hospital personnel COVID-19 vaccine rates begins

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services is posting hospital performance on its <u>health care personnel COVID-19 vaccination measure</u>. The measure was added to the agency's inpatient quality reporting and outpatient quality reporting programs in 2021 and reflects the proportion of hospital personnel completing the primary series of authorized COVID-19 vaccines.

The initial measure reflects hospital performance from October through December 2021. The data is refreshed quarterly on Care Compare. Additional items of note:

- The measure overlaps with, but is independent of, CMS' condition of participation mandating hospital worker COVID-19 vaccination.
- The measure data is not a precise reflection of hospital progress implementing CMS' vaccine mandate condition of participation.

The data does not reflect COVID-19 boosters.
