IHA advocacy team round up

The IHA advocacy team is continuing its work with the psychiatric intensive care work group. The group is in the rulemaking process and continues discussions about reimbursement. The state will host webinars for providers and claims processers further in the process.

This week, the advocacy team also:

- Discussed IHA's 2023 legislative priorities with Rep. Steven Bradley (R-Cascade). Bradley is the vice chair for the House Human Resources Committee.
- Met with IHA's Medicaid financing work group.
- Attended the Medicaid Matters Coalition and Mental Health and Disability Services Commission meetings.

Review PHE waivers and flexibilities in new webinar

The COVID-19 <u>public health emergency was extended</u> another 90 days on Thursday, Oct. 13, but it's anticipated to end in January. With the possible termination of the public health emergency, certain federal and state laws and government agency enforcement discretion waivers also may expire.

To help hospitals prepare, Dorsey and Whitney will address blanket waivers issued for hospitals by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services and which waivers the government may extend. Dorsey and Whitney attorneys also will discuss:

- · Conditions of participation.
- · Telehealth waivers.
- Steps for hospitals to take to prepare for the end of the public health emergency.

The <u>COVID-19 Public Health Emergency webinar</u> is scheduled from 2-3 p.m. Thursday, Dec. 1.

Dave joined MercyOne in 1993 as a technical consultant and has since held various leadership positions in the Clinical Laboratory and Performance Excellence Department. While working as a Six Sigma Black Belt, he improved patient flow for emergency departments by creating the Split Flow area, which is a process still used today. He has improved inpatient outcomes the past three years through focused attention on documentation and discharge communication for patients by creating a standard work flow for hourly rounds and bedside nurse handoffs. Technical assistance available for hospitals exploring REH

The <u>Rural Health Redesign Center</u> was awarded a grant from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services to provide technical assistance to rural hospitals in making informed decisions about the rural emergency hospital designation.

Interested hospitals will receive support, engagement and education about:

- Assessing the feasibility of a rural emergency hospital conversion.
- Completing the application process for conversion.
- Identifying alternative ways to meet community needs.
- Strategically planning for conversion.

IDPH moves to monthly monovalent COVID-19 allocation schedule

On Wednesday, Oct. 19, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the Food and Drug Administration approved the <u>Novavax monovalent COVID-19 booster</u> for people 18 and older. The Novavax vaccine targets the original COVID-19 strain.

Novavax is available for adults who:

- Cannot or will not receive an updated mRNA booster.
- Completed their primary vaccine series.
- Have not previously received a COVID-19 booster.

Also this week, the Iowa Department of Public Health began transitioning to a monthly COVID-19 vaccine allocation for monovalent COVID-19 vaccines. IDPH reminds providers that monovalent mRNA COVID-19 vaccines are not authorized as booster doses for people 5 and older.

IDPH is incorporating bivalent COVID-19 vaccine allocations and surveys into the monthly vaccine-ordering schedule as much as possible.
