## Department of Labor addresses nursing shortage through grant

The U.S. Department of Labor is addressing bottlenecks in nurse training through its new Nursing Expansion Grant Program. The program is designed to expand and diversify the pipeline of qualified nurses in health care through two approaches.\

**Nurse education professional track.** This program is increasing the number of nursing instructors and educators by training new or experienced current or former nurses, including retired nurses, into advanced post-secondary credentialing needed for nurses to become instructors and educators.

**Nursing career pathways track**. It trains nurses as frontline health care professionals and paraprofessionals to advance through a career pathway and gain the postsecondary credentials needed for middle- to high-skilled nursing positions.\

The Department of Labor <u>hosted a webcast with information about the grant program</u>, eligibility and application submission requirements. Applications are due Friday, Jan. 6, 2023.

## Staff well-being top concern in AONL study

Staff emotional health and well-being, retention and the cost of travel nurses are the top challenges facing nurse leaders according to the latest study by the American Organization for Nursing Leadership.

The four-part <u>Longitudinal Nursing Leadership Insight Study</u> looks at the impact of COVID-19 on nursing leadership in key areas over time. The survey shows the emotional health and well-being of nurse leaders is slightly improved but remains a top issue. Nurse leaders also reported the most difficult issues to respond to are:

- The availability of financial resources.
- · Health equity.
- · Staff retention.
- · Workplace violence including bullying and incivility.

The No Surprises Act was signed into law Dec. 27, 2020. The law protects patients from surprising medical bills and has taken price transparency to new levels by requiring providers to present a good faith estimate to uninsured or self-pay patients.
