HHS to start adjusting payment rates for certain 340B hospitals

The Department of Health and Human Services will begin restoring a payment rate of average sales price plus 6% for 340B drug claims in about two weeks, the department told a United State District Court for the District of Columbia.

In a brief filed Friday evening, HHS wrote it would make revisions to four electronic files and test the revisions before the files are loaded to calculate the OPSS reimbursements on a prospective basis.

Last week, the district court ruled in favor of the American Hospital Association, holding that HHS must immediately halt the department's unlawful cuts of nearly 30% to outpatient reimbursement rates for the remainder of 2022 for certain hospitals that participate in the 340B Drug Pricing Program.
