## IHA education council highlights workforce initiatives

The IHA Council on Education and Member Services met Wednesday, Nov. 9 with Laurie Conner, President, MercyOne Newton Medical Center presiding as chair. Workforce was the major topic of conversation during the meeting in line with this year's IHA membership survey results and IHA Board Retreat discussions indicating workforce should remain a priority for IHA in 2023.

Guest speaker Stephanie Sveen, RN, M.S.N., M.B.A.-HC, Mayo Clinic Nursing Placement Coordinator, discussed the organization's nursing student internship program and its nurse tech program. The programs offer students the opportunity for on-the-job training while providing Mayo Clinic a workforce pipeline.

IHA'S VICE President of Nursing and Clinical Services Jen Nutt spoke about IHA'S workforce initiatives to date and shared information from recent meetings with other state associations. With a wide range of possible initiatives, Nutt reported the intention to build a workforce strategic plan to focus IHA's efforts in 2023.

Council members approved additions and revisions to the IHA Hospital Board Certification program. Small group discussions provided input on proposed education topics for 2023. The Council's next meeting is April 4, 2023.

The five-session program was created through a partnership of the Iowa Hospital Association, Iowa Academy of Family Physicians, Iowa Healthcare Collaborative and the Iowa Medical Society.


