### **UNI nursing program approved by regents**

To help address nursing staffing shortages, the lowa Board of Regents approved the University of Northern Iowa's proposal to plan, develop and implement a <u>Bachelor of Science in Nursing program</u>. UNI President Mark Nook said he anticipates the program will launch in fall 2024.

The main objective of the program is to provide access to more seats at public schools to students seeking a nursing career and to ultimately increase the number of working nurses in lowa. Twenty-four students will be enrolled in the first program.

"IHA has advocated for more workforce initiatives to recruit and retain health care workers in the state, including initiatives to expand tuition reimbursement programs and incentives to recruit clinicians," said IHA Vice President of Nursing and Clinical Services Jen Nutt. "We're pleased nursing careers are becoming more accessible for lowans and look forward to working with colleges, universities and hospitals to create a robust health care workforce in lowa."

#### IHA advocacy team weekly round up

Several hospital champions were elected to the lowa legislature in Tuesday's midterm elections, and the IHA advocacy team is looking forward to establishing relations with newly elected lawmakers. The advocacy team is coordinating with hospital leaders to meet and present IHA's 2023 legislative priorities to the new legislators ahead of the 2023 session.

The IHA advocacy team this week also:

- Attended an AHA PAC webinar where it was announced the IHA PAC was one
  of only a handful of state hospital association PACs to meet or exceed its 2022
  fundraising goals.
- Met with the IHA Medicaid Finance work group.
- Presented IHA's 2023 legislative priorities at the IHA District A meeting.
