Webinar series addresses pediatric respiratory surge

More children are being treated for RSV, flu and COVID-19. To help nursing, providers and respiratory therapy clinical teams, the Region 1 Regional Disaster Health Response System and the Massachusetts General Hospital Center for Disaster Medicine are offering a weekly webinar series regarding providing care for pediatric patients with acute respiratory illness.

The educational series is comprised of six sessions covering:

- Assessment and management of pediatric patients with acute respiratory illness.
- Disposition planning.
- · High-flow nasal cannula therapy.
- Interim management for patients awaiting transfer for hospitalization.
- Noninvasive ventilation for pediatric patients.
- Safe pediatric intubation.

The sessions are scheduled weekly from 11 a.m.-noon from Thursday, Nov. 17 to Wednesday, Dec. 21. Recordings are available after each session.

Prepare for leading in a crisis

Being an effective leader means being prepared to lead during a crisis. IHA's <u>latest Lessons in Leadership</u> webinar will provide hospital leaders with the tools to stay calm while guiding their organizations during a crisis.

Bob McNaney, a crisis management and crisis communication strategy consultant, will offer examples of leadership during a crisis and give attendees opportunities to discuss each example in group discussions.

CMS releases voluntary sample formats for price transparency files

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services released three voluntary sample formats hospitals may use to meet the federal requirement to make certain standard charges publicly available through a machine-readable file. The formats include wide, tall and plain versions.

The agency also posted a sample data dictionary for the wide and tall formats.
