Experts from the Pediatric Pandemic Network and its federally funded partners are sharing resources to support immediate responses to the pediatric surge of RSV, flu and COVID-19.

### **PRF portal open for late reporting**

The Health Resources and Services Administration opened the [Provider Relief Fund reporting portal](#) for health care providers authorized to report late for provider relief fund payments. The reporting period is for payments made between Jan. 1 and June 30, 2021, totaling \$10,000.

After submitting a late report, providers have up to [30 days to return any unused funds](#) to HRSA.
