Pediatric surge resources available

Experts from the Pediatric Pandemic Network and its federally funded partners are sharing resources to support immediate responses to the pediatric surge of RSV, flu and COVID-19.

Several pediatric disaster subject matter groups created a <u>resource guide</u> with free and open-source resources highlighting:

- · Immediate resources.
- · Pediatric preparedness.
- Response recommendations.

PRF portal open for late reporting

The Health Resources and Services Administration opened the <u>Provider Relief Fund</u> <u>reporting portal</u> for health care providers authorized to report late for provider relief fund payments. The reporting period is for payments made between Jan. 1 and June 30, 2021, totaling \$10,000.

After submitting a late report, providers have up to <u>30 days to return any unused funds</u> to HRSA.

AONL rolls out nursing recruitment and retention best practices

The American Hospital Association's American Organization for Nursing Leadership released the first section in a three-part compendium focusing on <u>best practices to manage nursing workforce complexities</u>.

The first section focuses on recruiting and retaining nurses. Future sections will examine academic-practice partnerships, culture, compensation and benefits.
