lowa HHS seeking feedback for telehealth procedures post-PHE

On a Monday call about draft decisions for tehelealth billing after the COVID-19 public health emergency ends, the lowa Department of Health and Human Services presented its draft proposals for which telehealth procedure codes will remain in place or not continue. The draft proposals are divided into three categories:

- Telehealth issues and decisions.
- Telehealth recommendations, coverage.
- Telehealth recommendations, non-coverage.

lowa HHS is seeking provider feedback on the individual codes in the draft proposals. Email feeback to <u>ime_telehealth@dhs.state.ia.us</u>.

The COVID-19 public health emergency was extended to Jan. 11, 2023, but the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services said states will receive a 60-day notice of the end of the public health emergency.
