Federal Medicaid waivers remain despite end of state public health emergency

The Iowa public health disaster emergency expired Tuesday, Feb. 15. Although the state-declared public health emergency expired, the Iowa Medicaid Enterprise will still honor the federal Medicaid waivers in the federally declared public health emergency.

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services will give a 60-day notice of the

official end of the federal public health emergency.

IHA advocacy team gives first funnel week breakdown

The first legislative funnel week of 2022 wrapped up last week. IHA's advocacy team tracked more than 100 bills leading up to funnel week. Several IHA-backed bills were funnel-proof, meaning they did not need to pass committee to go to a floor debate.

After the first funnel week 58 IHA-tracked bills are still alive and 59 are dead. Several of the bills that died during funnel week would have negatively affected Iowa hospitals. IHA's advocacy team will monitor bills leading up to the next funnel week scheduled Friday, March 18.

Submit nominees for IHA's 2022 Leadership awards

IHA presents three major awards at its annual meeting to recognize significant achievement in hospital or health system administration and governances. The three awards are:

- **Excellence in Leadership Award** – Presented to an Iowa hospital or health system CEO demonstrating notable achievement in administration of the organization and contributions in the broader areas of health care or health policy.
- **Excellence in Governance Award** – Recognizes an outstanding trustee or board member making a significant contribution to the hospital or health system through their leadership and commitment to excellence.
- **Young Executive Achievement Award** – Presented to a hospital CEO under 40 showing significant positive influence in the community hospital or health

system.

Nominations are due to IHA by Wednesday, June 1, and must be submitted online.

IME to provide members rapid COVID-19 tests

The Iowa Medicaid Enterprise will provider members access to over-the-counter COVID-19 tests for the duration of the federal public health emergency. IME's coverage is different from over-the-counter COVID-19 test coverage under commercial plans with no reimbursement directly to Iowa Medicaid members who purchase tests. Iowa Medicaid members' COVID-19 tests must be obtained and billed through a provider. No prescription is required.

Providers and pharmacies that can bill as durable medical equipment providers on CMS-1500 medical claims can use HCPCS code T5999. No prior authorization is required for fee-for-service or in-network managed care organization providers.

Members are limited to one kit per member a day and up to four kits per member every 30 calendar days. Kits can be reimbursed up to \$25. PCR COVID-19 tests that are FDA-approved also will be covered.
