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Hospital trustees receive certification from Iowa Hospital Association


A group of [69 Iowa hospital trustees](#) and [18 Iowa hospital boards](#) were honored Friday, April 22, at the 2022 Iowa Hospital Association Governance Forum, an annual education conference for hospital trustees and governing boards.

[Certification from the Iowa Hospital Association](#) gives a framework for hospital trustees and governing boards to demonstrate their individual and collective commitment to their governance rolls and responsibilities. Participants earn

certification through education and governance best practices.

Trustees meet the certification requirements after completing 12 hours of health care-specific education over a two-year period and confirming individually and as a board that recognized governance best practices are being used. Hospitals and health systems also are recognized as one-, two- or three-star boards, depending on the percentage of board members certified.

Trustees and hospital boards show stakeholders their commitment to their communities through this program. More than 250 trustees and 25 hospitals are certified.

Summer Forum highlights future of health care through DEI

The [2022 Summer Leadership Forum](#) will kick off with two sessions exploring diversity, equity and inclusion in the health care environment. AHA equity roadmap launches tough conversations about DEI

Tim Voy, [Broadlawns Medical Center](#), spoke about Broadlawns' experience starting the [AHA Health Equity Roadmap](#) during IHA's Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Committee meeting Wednesday, April 20.

Voy said the initial Health Equity Transformation Assessment helped staff at Broadlawns identify their strengths and weaknesses in their DEI journey. He said the 26-page survey included questions about governance, staffing and vendor contracts. Once the survey is submitted to AHA, hospitals will receive their Transformation Action Planner in about four weeks. The action planner will identify resources and actionable tool kits for hospitals to use as they eliminate barriers that compromise diversity, equity and inclusion in hospitals.

Rising inflation increases input costs for hospitals, health systems

The American Hospital Association released a [new report examining the growth of input costs for hospitals and health systems](#) including expenses for workforce, drugs, supplies and equipment. The report also includes the impact of rising economywide inflation.

The surge in input costs combined with the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic continue to strain hospital resources. Highlights from the report include:

- Hospital employment is down 100,000 from pre-pandemic levels while the labor expenses per patient increased 19.1%.
- Median hospital drug expenses by the end of 2021 were 28.2% higher than pre-pandemic levels.
- Supply expenses for hospitals were 15.9% higher at the end of 2021.
