### Reimbursement, board nominees highlight IHA board retreat

The Insurance Market Place and reimbursement to hospitals were main topics of discussion during the IHA board meeting, Wednesday, Aug. 10, held in conjunction with the joint planning session of the IHA, ServiShare and IHERF boards. IHA President and CEO Chris Mitchell reviewed the makeup of IHA's Medicaid financial work group developed to work with IHA's Medicaid consultant. At its June meeting, the IHA Board unanimously approved contracting with Health Management Associates to help develop strategies and identify possible options for increasing Medicaid reimbursements.

The board unanimously approved Doug Cropper, president and CEO of Genesis Healty System, and Matt Wenzel, president and CEO of Greath River Health, to fill board vacancies along with the IHA Governance Committee recommendations for IHA's 2022/2023 board nominees and leadership positions. The slate of officers and trustees will be voted on by the membership at the IHA House of Delegates meeting Oct. 4.

AHA Region 6 Executive Elizabeth Summy provided an American Hospital Association board update followed by state and federal legislative updates. Reports also were received from the ServiShare and IHERF boards. Four new IHA associate members were approved.

The next meeting of the IHA Board of Officers and Trustees is scheduled Monday, Oct. 3, a day before the IHA Annual Meeting.

### IHA advocacy team weekly roundup

IHA's advocacy team and hopspital leaders are completing discussions regarding IHA's 2023 legislative priorities. IHA created four work groups this summer to discuss:

- Certificate of need.
- Maternal health.

- · Pharmacy issues.
- · Workforce.

The pharmacy issues work group held is final session Tuesday. The certificate-of-need, maternal health and workforce groups are continuing to meet.

All groups will present their goals to the IHA Council on Representation and Advocacy at its Sept. 21 meeting. If approved, the priorities will be integrated into IHA's advocacy agenda and be presented to the IHA Board of Officers and Trustees in October during the IHA Annual Meeting.

# HRSA announces funding opportunity for rural hospitals

Rural hospitals can apply for one of 46 grants through the <u>Small Rural Hospital</u> <u>Improvement Program</u>. The Health Resources and Services Administration anticipates nearly \$21 million will be available for a five-year project period from June 1, 2023, to May 31, 2028.

The program's purpose is to help small hospitals with 49 beds or less implement quality and operational improvement efforts that align with value-based care. Improvement projects can include:

- · Bundling payments.
- Joining a Medicare shared savings program or accountable care organizations.
- Promoting interoperability.
- · Purchasing hardware and software.
- Training staff.

Applications are due Tuesday, Nov. 8.

# Provider escalation guide available through DHS

At a recent Medicaid provider town hall meeting, the <u>lowa Department of Human</u> <u>Services released a provider escalation guide.</u> The resource identifies pathways for providers to escalate issues and concerns about:

- Claim payment issues.
- · Contracting.
- · Credentialing.
- · Provider enrollment.
