2022 IHA Annual Meeting returns to in-person event

After two years of virtual meetings, hospital leaders and advocates will meet in-person at the Community Choice Credit Union Convention Center in Des Moines for the [2022 IHA Annual Meeting](#). Iowa's largest gathering of hospital leaders and colleagues is scheduled from Tuesday, Oct. 4 to Wednesday, Oct. 5, with a preconference workshop at the IHA Conference Center Monday, Oct. 3.

This year's conference will help hospital leaders recharge and rebuild after grappling with the COVID-19 pandemic, workforce shortages and a myriad of issues. The meeting will be filled with sessions for hospital leaders, trustees, clinical staff and everyone in between. Engaging keynote speakers include:

CMS issues final rule for hospital inpatient and LTCH final rule

The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services released its fiscal year [2023 final rule for the hospital inpatient and long-term care hospital prospective payment system](#) this week.

The final rule will [increase inpatient prospective patient payments by a net 2.6% compared to 2022](#). The increase reflects:

- A 4.3% rate update. The update is a 4.1% market basket update, less 0.3 percentage points for productivity plus 0.5 percentage points required by statute.
- A 1.7% cut for outlier payments.

The final rule also will [increase net long-term care hospital perspective payments by \\$71 million](#) in fiscal year 2023, relative to previous levels. It also caps decreases for annual payment system updates to MS-LTC-DRF relative weights and the wage index. This will help maintain year-to-year stability.

IHA and Iowa hospitals advocated for a rate increase in the originally-proposed rule because of the economic situation in the U.S. IHA is pleased to see the updated rates in the final rule.
