## Cyber criminals targeting health care payment systems

The FBI reported cyber criminals are redirecting payments intended for health care providers to accounts they control by targeting health care payment processors.

In its alert, the <u>FBI said at least 68 attacks were reported since June 2018</u>. Cyber criminals used publicly available personal information and social engineering to impersonate victims and access accounts. The FBI recommends applying mitigations including:

- Conducting regular network security assessments.
- Regularly patching security threats.
- Updating anti-virus and anti-malware software.
- Using multi-factor authentication for all accounts and login credentials whenever possible.

# Report period 3 PRF payment Sept. 30

Health care providers who received provider relief fund payments exceeding \$10,000 total from Jan. 1 to June 30, 2021, must report to the Health Resources and Services Administration by Friday, Sept. 30, about how the funds were used. Failure to report can result in enforcement actions including repayment or exclusion from receiving or retaining future payments.

The deadline to use the period 3 payments was Thursday, June 30.
