IHA advocacy team weekly round up

The IHA advocacy team and the Iowa Department of Health and Human Services are continuing discussions with the psychiatric intensive care work group about Medicaid rate development. The work group also reviewed the administrative rule submission status and the billing process.

The advocacy team attended a <u>Brain Health Now</u> webinar. Brain Health Now is working with educators, health care professionals and business leaders to end the stigma surrounding brain health illnesses. Representatives from community health centers, public school districts, hospitals and the Mental Health Disability Services regions spoke about their partnerships with the organization.

The <u>2023 Leadership Development Program</u> (LDP) is open to new hospital leaders and managers or experienced hospital leaders looking to refresh their skills.

The LDP prepares participants for their new leadership or managerial roles with a multidimensional approach. Participants learn new leadership skills and how to work as a team.

Bebtelovimab commercially available for purchase

The federal government made its final order of the COVID-19 therapeutic drug bebtelovimab Tuesday, Sept. 6, but will still supply replacement doses when a provider:

- Has no inventory of U.S.-government supplied bebtelovimab.
- Used a commercially purchased dose for treatment of an uninsured or underinsured patient.

The Department of Health and Human Services provided guidance to <u>determine if</u> <u>providers qualify for replacement doses</u>.

Providers with insured patients or patients with Medicare or Medicaid can begin purchasing bebtelovimab. Sites with an AmerisourceBergen account will be granted immediate access to buy the drug. Site without an account must register for an account <u>by emailing AmerisourceBergen</u> first.
